Ballet 1-2 -3 - ages 7 and up and must have completed Variety Level 2 or be at least 7 years old for a new student.

Ballet 4 –5 - must be approved by teacher.

Tap

Tap 1-2 - must have completed Variety Level 2 or be at least 7 years old for a new student.

Tap 3-4 - must be approved by teacher..

Lyrical

Little Lyrical - ages 6 – 7.

Lyrical 1-2 - must be at least 7 years old and completed 1 year of Ballet.

<u>Lyrical-3-4</u> - must be approved by teacher.

<u>Jazz</u>

<u>Jazz-1-2</u> - must have completed Variety Level 2 or be at least 7 years old for a new student.

<u>Jazz-3-4</u> - must be approved by teacher.

Hip Hop

<u>Little Hoppers</u> - ages 5 to 7 <u>Hip Hop 1-2</u> - ages 7 and up.

<u>Toddlin' Twos</u> – for mommy and child. We do ballet, tumbling and tap in this class. This is for those children who just want to dance under the age of three.

<u>Young Expression</u> for ages 3-4. It is a 45 minute class consisting of ballet, tap, and tumbling.

Young Expression Level 1—ages 3 or 4 for a first year student.

Dress Code for Dancers

Ballet, and Lyrical-

<u>Females</u>: Black or Pink leotard and tights, hair in bun and pink ballet shoes. **Skirts are only allowed if teacher says it is okay.**

Males: Black stretch pants, white shirt, and black Ballet shoes

Jazz and Tap-

Females: any color leotard and tights, and hair must be up and out of face. You may wear Jazz pants with teacher approval. Any type of Jazz or Tap shoes. Check with your teacher as to the color for recital.

<u>Males</u>: Any color shirt (with no improper writing) with stretch pants. Any kind of Jazz or Tap shoe.

Hip Hop-

Comfortable clothing, (no jeans) clean white bottom tennis shoes that are not to be worn outside on the street. Jazz shoes may be worn.

Toddlin' Two, Young Expressions and Variety-

<u>Females</u>: Any colored leotard and tights, and hair up and out of face, pink leather ballet shoes and black tap shoes. They may wear a skirt if they wish.

<u>Males</u>: White shirt and black sweat pants. Black ballet, tap, or jazz shoes.

Acro - Leotard
