- Get costumes ready for Dress Rehearsal. Make sure you have everything.
- **Recital Rehearsal (May 17)** starts promptly at 4:30 p.m. Be in assigned seats in the auditorium for instructions. Doors open at 3:30 p.m. We will rehearse Recital numbers in order then Solo & Duet Extravaganza.
- **Solo & Duet Extravaganza (May 18)** starts promptly at 12:15 p.m. Doors open at 11:30 p.m. Dressed and ready by 12:00 p.m. You must be seated by 12:15 p.m. to attend this show.
- **Recital (May 18)** starts promptly at 2:00 p.m. Doors open at 1:30 p.m. **(Ushers will not seat patrons from 12:15 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. during the Solo and Duet Extravaganza show).** Dressed and ready by 1:45 p.m.
- At the end of our recital program all dancers will be lined up in the hallway outside the stage door on the Miller Street side. Helpers will bring down all dancers from the balcony. We will have a short curtain call and introduce our staff. Dancers should be lined up in the hall three dances from the end of the show. Parents may pick up their dancer from the stage after Bows.
