- It is not too late to register, invite your friends, neighbors, cousins, anyone is welcome to join us!

COVID Policies & Procedures

- We will continue the rules & policies for the health & safety of our dancers as we did last year's dance session with the exception of taking temperatures at the door. We ask for everyone's patience & understanding to help make things go smoothly. Also, a big thank you for everyone's cooperation with the COVID procedures thus far!
- **If you have been ill or anyone in your home has been ill or had a temperature of more than 100.4 in the last 72 hours, please do not come to dance!**
- We will continue to keep all dressing rooms closed. We ask that you bring

your dancer to the front door and they wear their dance attire & not bring other clothing into the studio. We ask that you bring a small bag/backpack containing dance shoes & any other dance attire necessities (ex ballet skirt, water bottle). We will continue to sell water at the front desk if you are interested.

- Please do not come to the studio early, as we do not have a waiting room for sitting while you wait.
- We ask that the dancers will wait on the "X's" on the floor in the waiting room while they wait for the teacher to call them to class. We have taped grids on our dance floors to respect social distancing. For reference, check out our COVID procedure video on our Facebook page.
- At this time, we are still not allowing parents in the studio to watch dancers. Please stay in your car or run errands etc. We will end class 10 minutes early & releasing students one by one to exit through the front door. We are using this time to

sanitize the room including floors before the next class comes in.

- Parents may briefly come into the studio to make your tuition payment & then immediately leave the studio, as we are trying our best to decrease any types of crowds in the studio. You can also call the studio at (573) 636-4528 to make a payment over the phone.
