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5-6-7-8 RECITAL GUIDELINES

REHEARSAL — Friday, May 18, 4:30 p.m. The Miller Performing Arts Center will be open at 3:30 p.m. You must enter through the side door on Miller Street. Dancers need to be ready (makeup and costume) and sitting in the assigned seats in the auditorium at 4:30 p.m. You may wish to do hair and makeup at home and put the costume on at Miller. Please do not wear your costume to Miller. This is a good time to wear your recital T-shirts.

Only two family members with paid tickets to our Saturday show are allowed into the rehearsal. If you have a guest that cannot attend Saturday you can buy tickets for the rehearsal show. **YOU MUST BRING YOUR TICKETS WITH YOU OR YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE REHEARSAL.**

The recital rehearsal will begin **PROMPTLY** at 4:30 p.m. We will go in recital order except for those in the solo and duet extravaganza and they will rehearse immediately after the regular rehearsal. When you have finished with all your numbers, you are free to go.

Please feel free to bring a camera or a video camera to the rehearsal. This is your opportunity to take all the video and pictures of your child that you want, as there will be absolutely no video or pictures taken during the recital. You may only film your child's performances. If you do plan to videotape any part of the rehearsal, please complete a Rehearsal Video Taping Release Form available at the front desk.

For those of you that will be at the rehearsal for an extended time, please do not eat or drink with your costume on. The only place that food and drink is allowed is in the 'green' room.



ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD, DRINK OR GUM IN THE MILLER AUDITORIUM, ON STAGE OR BACKSTAGE. If food or drink is found, the studio will be required to forfeit our deposit. This includes water. Thanks for your assistance.

RECITAL — Our Solo and Duet Extravaganza will begin Saturday, May 19, at 12:15 p.m. If you are performing a solo or duet, you must be dressed and ready backstage no later than 12:00 noon. Those wishing to watch the Solo and Duet Extravaganza must be seated in their seats promptly by 12:15 p.m. No admittance into the auditorium will be given during the solo performances.

The regular recital will begin at 2:00 p.m. You must enter through the side door on Miller Street, get your child dressed for their first number and leave them with the parent class helper in the dressing room and then you can go be seated. The doors to the auditorium will open to patrons at 1:30 p.m. All recital dancers should be dressed and ready by 1:45 p.m.. Please remember: do not wear your costume to Miller.

For your child's safety, we are asking you to do the following. All parent class helpers should be here at 1:30 p.m. All Young Expression 1, 2, Variety 1, 2 dancers should be assisted to the balcony no later than 1:45 p.m. by their parent class helper unless you are in the first 4 numbers who will line up backstage. When each performance is finished, the dancers will be escorted back to the balcony by the parent class helper. **NO CHILD MAY BE PICKED UP BACKSTAGE BY THEIR PARENT.**

We highly suggest if at all possible everyone stay for the entire recital because all of our dancers have worked very hard on their dances and deserve a great audience. If you must leave early, you must go to the balcony and pick up your child from the class parent helper. Previous arrangements must be made in writing and only parents may pick up their child. Forms available at the front desk.

If you wish for your child to sit with you after their performance, you must buy them a ticket because they have a seat in the balcony [children can be picked up in the balcony by a parent only and not backstage].

At the end of the recital we will have a final bow which includes all dancers. You may pick up your dancer from the stage after the show.
